

Pathway: Everyday Outdoor Skills

This trail takes about 1 - 2 hours to complete (depending on the size and attention of your group). The activities are fun and engaging for kids and adults. These activities lean toward some of the Survival and outdoor activities, and provide opportunity to take part in teamwork with parents and friends. Great for a group of 4 – 8 people.
