

### **Wolf pathway “Call of the Wild”**

This pathway takes about 2-3 hours to complete (depending on the size and attention of your group). The activities are fun and engaging for kids and adults. These activities lean toward some of the outdoor skills activities, and provide opportunity to unleash a child’s appreciation for nature. Great for a group of 4 – 8 people.
