

Wolf pathway “Code of the Wolf”

This pathway takes about 2-3 hours to complete (depending on the size and attention of your group). The activities are fun and engaging for kids and adults. These activities lean toward some of the investigation activities, and provide opportunity to unleash a child’s inquisitive skills. Great for a group of 4 – 8 people.

Place to visit	Activity	Wolf Adventure Requirement
STEM Room	With the members of your den or family, make a game with simple materials that requires math to keep score.	Req. 1a
STEM Room/Outdoors	Do 5 activities in your den that use mathematics and explain how you used everyday math.	Req. 1c
Nature & Ecology	With other members of your den or family, identify 3 different types of shapes that you see in nature.	Req. 2a
STEM Room	With your den or family, measure the height of everyone in the group and see who takes more steps to walk 100 feet.	Req. 3b
STEM Room	Use a secret code using numbers to send a message to one of your den members. Have that person send a message back to you. Be sure you both use the same code.	Req. 4a
